



## **Canadian Medical Protective Association**

Physicians and trainees engaged in clinical services with AHS must submit (email/fax/hardcopy) proof of malpractice coverage to their Clinical Departments or Programs for verification and forwarding to Medical Affairs. Coverage is typically through the Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA).

## In order to become a member of the CMPA:

- 1. You must be registered with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta (CPSA).
