

Claiming CME Credits for OFDP Workshops

Overview

Non-certified credits are awarded for those activities that have not been formally reviewed by the College but that comply with the College's definition of CPD.

CFPC Members:

NON-CERTIFIED ACTIVITIES - All non-certified activities are eligible for one non-certified credit per hour of participation.

Self-study using enduring materials (e.g., podcasts, monographs, videos, e-learning modules)

RCPSC Members:

RCPSC members can claim hours under MOC Section 2 Self-Learning as follows:

Reading a journal article - 1 credit per article

Podcasts, audio, video - 0.5 credits per activity

Personal learning projects - 2.0 credits per hour

Group learning activities = 0.5 credit per hour of participation (50 credits maximum per cycle).

Unaccredited activities include participation as a learner/attendee in:

Rounds, journal clubs, small-group activities or conferences that have not been submitted for accreditation and have no industry sponsorship.
